THE IDEA

Environmental intelligence that disappears into the living world. Sensing instruments shaped like vines and creatures rather than plastic boxes. A whole property that knows where you are, so you can speak to your garden from anywhere — and it answers like a naturalist: what visited last night, where the water went, what the roses need. Then the bigger step: connected gardens comparing notes — rain measured cistern by cistern across a neighborhood, soil moisture block by block, and new science flowing into every garden's practice the season it's published instead of a career later.

WHAT EXISTS TODAY

A working foundation, not a slide deck. H2OS — live sensor control of cisterns, rain capture, and irrigation — already runs in real client gardens through three decades of California water-wise design practice (Comfort Zones Garden Design & Build). On the other side: proven AI orchestration — voice agents, autonomous automation, and knowledge-flow systems built and running daily. The connective tissue between them is what we're here to build.

WHY NOW

The pieces are individually proven: community weather meshes improve with every station (WeatherFlow Tempest), thousands of households will host garden soil sensors when asked (CurieuzeNeuzen, 5,000 gardens), and AI can finally read the scientific literature at the pace it's written. Nobody has connected them. Industry practice still adopts new environmental science one career at a time — 83% of landscape professionals use no AI at all. The gap is the opportunity: a mesh that moves knowledge, not just data.

WHO WE'RE LOOKING FOR

- **Landscape craftspeople** — who want their installs to keep learning after the truck leaves
- **Sensor & hardware engineers** — who think instruments should look grown, not manufactured
- **Ecologists & horticulturists** — tired of watching good science wait decades for adoption
- **AI builders** — drawn to automation that serves living systems, not just ledgers
- **First gardens** — owners in Southern California with the itch to go first

THE ASK

A conversation. This is an idea with working roots, honestly presented — we start as a consultancy (AI environments and automation for people and businesses) while we find the allies to build the rest. Bring a capability; we'll bring the direction.
